

NATIONAL NATIVE AMERICAN EMS ASSOCIATION CALL FOR NOMINATIONS FOR BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Anyone interested in running for a two (2) year term as a member of the Board of Directors will have until **October 7, 2011** to submit a written request (see below) to run for a position. To be eligible for a position, you must be a current active member of NNAEMSA (October 1, 2011 – September 30, 2012) and must have been an active member for the previous year (October 1, 2010 – September 30, 2011 membership year). Two board member positions are open in this year's election.

The Board meets in person one to two times a year: at the Annual Educational Conference and again usually in March if the budget allows. Conference call meetings are scheduled as necessary. Duties include representing the membership of NNAEMSA, attending and participating in meetings of the Board, serving on various committees that plan the Annual Educational Conference as well as coordinating and working the conference, overseeing and directing the activities of NNAEMSA staff & volunteers, soliciting volunteers for NNAEMSA, soliciting donations and other resources for NNAEMSA, recruiting new members, conducting other Association business and actively promoting NNAEMSA and Tribal EMS.

All candidates will have the opportunity to give a five (5) minute speech about themselves at the 20th Annual Educational Conference. Voting will take place at the conference. Only active members will be eligible to vote. **The results will be announced at the awards luncheon that is held on Thursday November 10, 2011.**
